

Tassled Hat

This hat uses a rectangle that fits around your neck (about 15 inches) on the short side with an overall ratio of 3:5. The knit should be loose enough to slide a button between the stitches, so a knitangle worked in bulky yarn on big needles is ideal.

You Will Need

1 rectangle, approx. 15 x 25" (38 x 63cm)
 matching or contrasting yarn
 2 large buttons
 sewing thread, yarn needle, and sewing needle

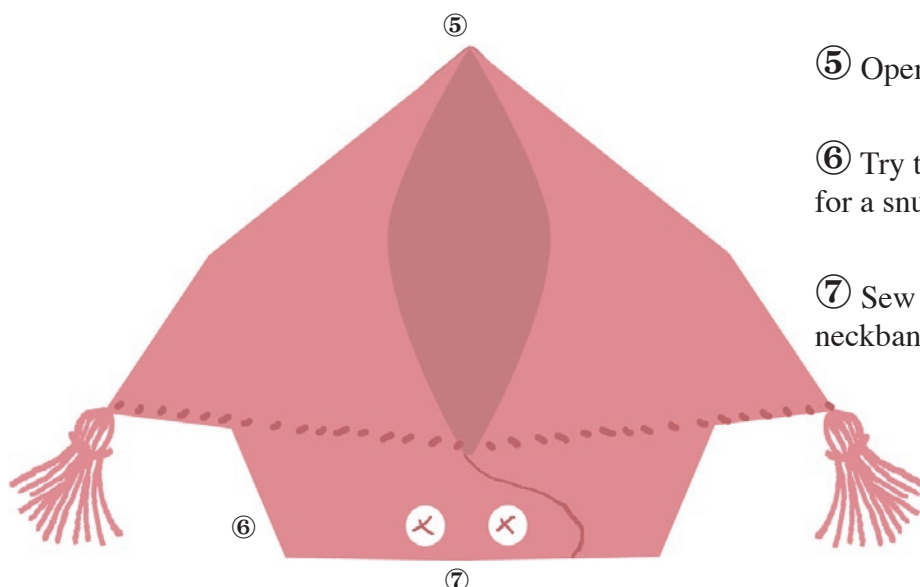
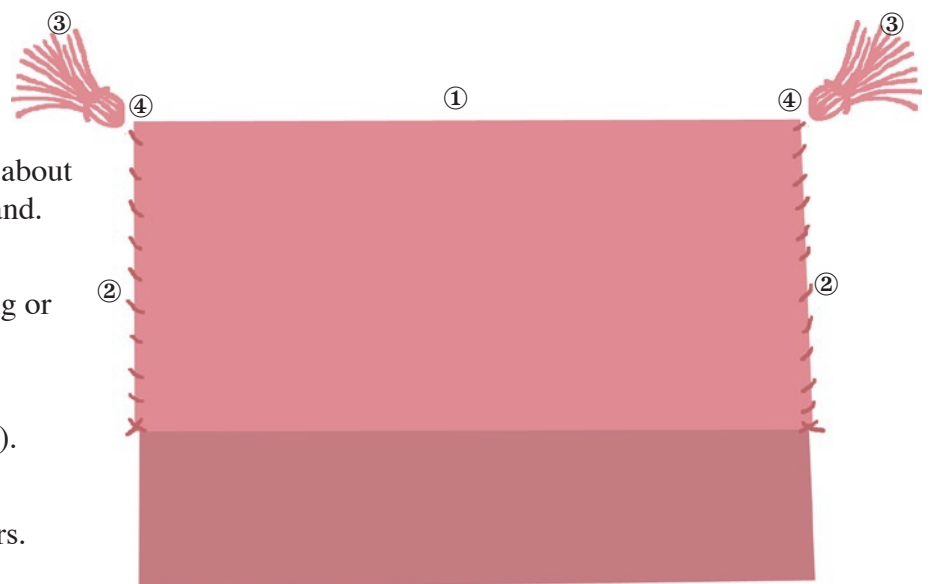

The finished hat keeps your ears toasty warm, and the neckband fits well inside most coat collars, but the hat doesn't cover the forehead, so you may find it unsuitable for very cold weather.

How to Make

- ① Fold the long edge over, leaving about 4" open at the bottom for the neckband.
- ② Sew the edges shut with matching or contrasting yarn.
- ③ Create two tassels (or pom poms).
- ④ Stitch tassels to the folded corners.



- ⑤ Open the hat out and fold vertically.
- ⑥ Try the hat on, overlapping the neckband for a snug fit.
- ⑦ Sew two buttons onto bottom side of neckband.
